



UCLB 2017 Stewardship Campaign Frequently Asked Questions & Guidance

How many campaigns are there?

There are **TWO** campaigns. The first is the traditional stewardship campaign for pledges for the 2017 operating budget. The second is unique and is for our church's Capital Campaign. The capital campaign is a one-time program to raise funds for long-term capital projects of the church including the building of a new manse.

Is there a simple way I can distinguish the two campaigns?

Yes. The stewardship campaign provides funds for our **present** needs; specifically the 2017 operating budget. The capital campaign provides funds for our **future** and major projects we need to take on in the future.

Is there one campaign that is more important than the other?

We desire people give primary consideration to the stewardship campaign and funding the operating budget for 2017. Our budget is lean and we need members/friends to continue to pledge to fund us for 2017. We do not want a desire to support the capital campaign to detract from what a person would otherwise pledge.

When can I indicate my support and when should I make payment?

The traditional stewardship campaign opened October 2nd and will run for six weeks. We would desire all pledges be made on or before Nov 13th. We would expect pledges to be paid during 2017, but understand some may pay in 2016 for tax purposes. The capital campaign is open through December 31, 2016. Those desiring to support the campaign should indicate such by year end. You can structure your commitment over 2016 thru 2019. We would expect payment during the year(s) you indicate.
